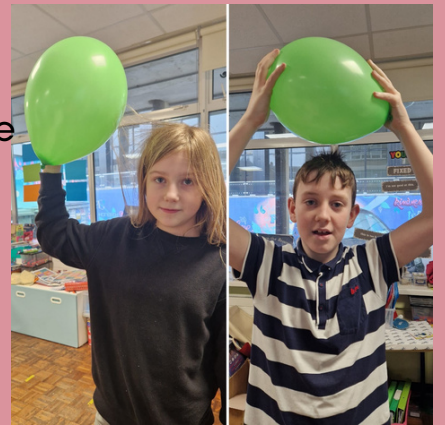

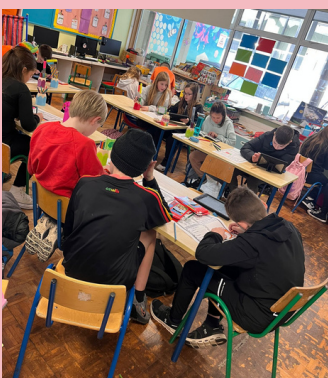
## ROOM 1

## ROOM 3

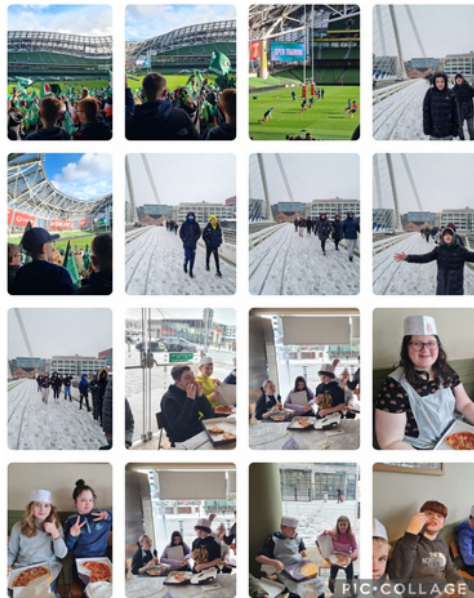
We have been working really hard in Room 3. We sent our books away last week for the Write a Book competition.
