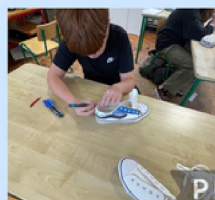
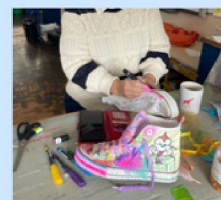
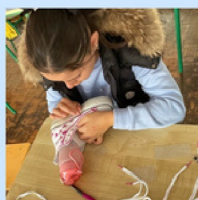
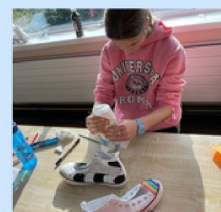
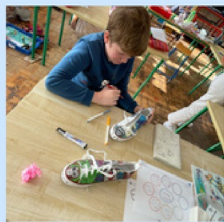
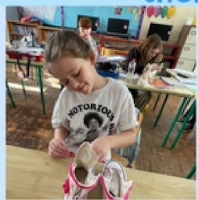


Rooms 4 and 5 celebrated National Tree Day with Ms. Kennedy in the garden.
