Room 7 enjoying a hot chocolate after attending The Giggler at The Ark Theatre.

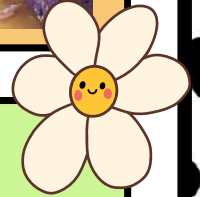
ROOM 6
